The Nordic countries already have a long history of cross-border cooperation in the electricity market sector and source also a large part of its power supply from renewable energy. How to continue this path and achieve further decarbonisation?

In their report <u>Nordic Energy Ways in Europe</u> the Nordic Action Group on Climate and Energy (NAG), a business platform established as part of the Energy and Climate Program of Global Utmaning, an independent Stockholm based think tank, takes a closer look at the European/Nordic energy potential. Which ways forward are the most sustainable, most efficient ones? Is there a potential for closer Nordic and Northern European integration?
